She is a formal and informal advisor to superintendents and board members in various districts throughout the Central Texas region. In 2005, she was recognized as a "Hero for Children" by the State Board of Education for her outstanding volunteer service to the children of Texas. Dawson has a BS in Civil Engineering *Cum Laude* from Princeton University and an MBA with highest honors in Information Systems Management from the University of Texas McCombs School of Business.
